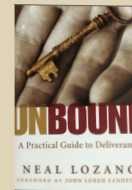
Unbound ministry **applies the five keys to freedom** to a real story.

## DELIVERANCE IS A GOOD WORD!

(Neal Lozano, *Unbound*)

**Most people misunderstand deliverance.** They think that it's only for possessed individuals, and that it can only be done by a trained and appointed exorcist. Others believe that it's something only for "charismatics," or that it's necessarily frightening. People often confuse deliverance with emotional or mental healing.

None of these capture the true nature of deliverance ministry, a ministry that simply **acknowledges the reality of spiritual battle in every human life.** Yet Christians, while subject to Satan's constant opposition, can never be overpowered by the enemy; he can only gain authority in their lives to the degree that they give him access.

**How?** By believing lies, engaging in sin, harboring unforgiveness, forming unholy and unhealthy relationships, or approaching the occult with fear and fascination. **Deliverance ministry closes these doors** and releases people to live freely, secure in their identity as God's beloved children. **It unlocks their lives so that they can move forward into the purposes and plans that God has for them.**

As such, deliverance does closely align with healing. For the greatest healing of all is healing from sin and from its inevitable outcomes: misery, destruction, and eventually death. **Deliverance is a spiritual healing,** and we need to understand that ...

**deliverance is a good word!**

## FIVE KEYS TO FREEDOM

### Key One

**Repent** for your sins and **believe** in Jesus.

### Key Two

**Forgive** others ... and yourself.

### Key Three

**Renounce** the work of Satan, his influence in your life.

### Key Four

Stand in the **authority** of Jesus Christ and say no to evil.

### Key Five

Receive the Father's **blessing** on your identity and destiny.



## What happens in Unbound ministry?

Many models of healing or deliverance prayer rely on the gifting of the minister, perhaps accompanied by supernatural signs or physical manifestations. Unbound ministry, in contrast, is really **led by the person receiving prayer.**

Trained prayer leaders stand alongside individuals seeking deliverance, usually in a **one-time private appointment lasting an hour or two.**

The first part of the prayer session is best described as **active listening guided by the Holy Spirit.** Many people experience this as a time of revelation, when they recognize how they have accepted deception leading to bondage, and they understand in a new way the truth that sets them free. In the next part of the prayer time, the prayer leader guides the person in **praying through each of the five keys** in depth.

Through Unbound prayer, many people find liberty to live the life God has always intended for them. They learn how to win their ongoing spiritual battles. **Most of all, they experience the truth of the Father's deep, unchangeable, personal love.**
